Directions to Carmel High Pool

An easy_method to get to the pool is to take **Keystone Parkway** (Formerly Keystone Avenue) to the 136th Street exit which is one of Carmel's famous new roundabouts. Exit the roundabout heading West for less than 1 block from the roundabout and turn left onto **Stadium Drive** and follow it to the turnaround by Entrance 21N where you can unload, marked on the photo. Then you must move your vehicle to the parking area.

The address is **520E Main Street, Carmel, IN 46033**. However, that will get you to the front of the high school, not at the back (North) side where you will need to go.
